# Parking Guidance



This year we are continuing our work towards improving the safety for children and the local residents during drop off and pick up times. It is a very busy time and we are aware of the challenges that children, parents, carers and residents face with the number of cars that come and go in a short space of time. The safety and health of our children is a key priority and we would like to thank all parents and carers who do drive and park safely.

We would like to ask all parents and carers to continue working with us this year to keep our children safe by following our Parking Guidance.

### Foulds Safer Parking Guidance

- The safety of our children is our key priority
- Drive safely, with due care and attention, and in accordance with the Highway Code at all times
- Reduce driving speeds to a maximum of 20mph on the roads around the school
- Be continually aware of children who are walking, scooting or cycling in the local area when driving or parking a car
- Obey the parking restrictions around the school at all times and if needed be prepared to park further away and walk
- There should be no parking or stopping momentarily on the zig-zag lines outside the school gates to drop
  off or pick up passengers. The markings are there to provide a clear area in which Foulds children can cross
  more safely.
- Double yellow lines—unless you have a disabled parking permit, you are not permitted to park on double yellow lines at any time.
- Be considerate in choosing a place to park that does not impact on pedestrian safety or local residents
- Turn off your engine when safely stopped to reduce idling fumes

# Park and Stride

We are very keen to encourage even more of our children to scoot, cycle, walk and park and stride to school this year and we hope that parents and carers will support us in this.



We have numerous bike and scooter parks at school for children to use each day and you are parking and striding we ask that parents and carers use the roads nearer to QE Boys


