FOULDS SPORTS NEWS Development Match



A power cut at Underhill School saw the Underhill B vs Foulds B being postponed. However the squad made the best of it, taking on Foulds Yr5 instead at Byng Road in an entertaining match.

The game against Underhill has been rearranged for Thursday 11th July (4pm KO at Underhill Juniors).

Cricket Season Starts

Cricket season got underway with a double friendly against Osidge at Old Elizabethans Cricket Club. Following open trials and a couple of sessions at Byng Road, two teams were selected and ready to play their first inter-school games.

Foulds Girls vs Osidge Girls

At bat, Foulds Girls took a while to get going. In the first 3 overs, whilst only losing one wicket, runs were hard to come by leaving the team on 4. A couple of boundaries in the 4th over and then a hat-trick of boundaries in the 5th helped boost the score. However three outs in the 6th and 7th overs left Foulds on just 20 for the visitors to chase.

In the field, the girls showed the consistency in their bowling that they've been working on in training, meaning it was now the visitors struggling for runs. Foulds took 4 wickets in the 3rd and 4th overs, taking 5 runs off Osidge's total for each. Despite a rally in the final overs, Foulds held on, leaving their opponents on 16, 4 short of Foulds' total.

Foulds Boys vs Osidge Boys

Foulds were put into bat but wasted no time in

asserting themselves. The first batting pairing scored a very healthy 36. Overs 3 and 4 saw 8 more runs added after deducting a wicket. The 3rd batting pair didn't lose a wicket and added 20 runs to put the team on 64 before the final pair added

another 10 after the deduction of a couple of wickets. Foulds therefore finished their innings on a very solid 74 for Osidge to chase.

As Osidge went out to bat, the Foulds team got off to a blistering start in the field. The first over saw 2 wickets fall and Osidge only score through one 'no-ball' - leaving them on -13. The Foulds bowling attacked stayed on top, limiting their opponents to singles mostly in the remaining overs. In fact the visitors could only muster two boundaries in their innings - leaving them on 7 after the alloted 8 overs - well adrift of the target set by Foulds.

Development Game

Players not involved in the Osidge games were involved in a development game - giving all involved plenty of opportunities for batting, bowling, wicket keeping and fielding. Consistency was worked on to develop their all round game. There were some impressive performances showing we have plenty of depth in the squad this year with a large number of Y5s.

Next up: It's back to Byng Road for training before another development event at Old Elizabethan's Cricket Club on 21st May. Some children will be selected for the Borough tournaments on 23rd May and subsequent League games vs Cromer Road, All Saints and St Andrews.
