Happy New Year and welcome back to a new decade at Foulds!

The children have had a fantastic start to the new term, showing wonderful behaviour for learning and attitudes around the school, as well as modelling our values of resilience, respect, teamwork, self-belief, kindness & responsibility beautifully.

My assembly on Tuesday was about believing in yourself and it being 'Good to be Me'. We thought about what made us special and therefore unique in our own right. I told the children a story about a mouse that didn't believe in itself but went on to save the day. My key message was that sometimes it is difficult to have a strong self-belief but, as a staff, we all believe in every child in the school and it is okay for a child to be catching up with us in believing in themselves, or to have a day where they lose their self-belief, but that it is important at those moments, to think about why they are special and remember to begin to believe in themselves again.
