Some exciting news this week. Elle Callaghan, has been successful in bidding to be our new uniform supplier. Next week in the newsletter she will introduce herself properly but for now let me give you a little more information.

The only change to our school uniform policy will be that, from next year, ties will only be worn by our Year 6 children. This is so that they stand out in our mixed Year 5/6 classes and in the school and can be looked to as clear role models. The tie for the Year 6 will still be optional, but we see it as a great way of preparing them for secondary school, where the majority will have to wear one.

Over the next year we are going to phase out the school fleece that children wear in class. We will continue to sell the reversible fleece jacket but this is for outdoor wear. We now have two thicknesses of school jumper and cardigan available and a polo shirt that has the school emblem should you wish your child to wear one. None of the above is compulsory and if you wish to buy from a supermarket that is still fine. On the website there are tights available in the correct colours (grey and bottle green) and lots of hair products in the school green!

For PE, we are introducing a new hoody and two types of PE trousers. We do find that children are not necessarily bringing winter PE kits into school and this is an expectation. Our policy states that the PE tracksuits must be dark and plain and this is something that we are going to tighten up on over the rest of this academic year as we do tend to find a wide array of colours have crept into our PE lessons!

The final exciting product that we are looking forward to offering in the not too distant future is a Foulds water bottle. The children in KS2 will be able to buy a bottle with a lid colour matching their house, whilst EYFS and KS1 will have their own special colour lid. Again there is no expectation to buy a bottle but we thought this was a useful, sustainable and environmentally friendly idea to offer.

They took full control of the game, keeping St Andrews pinned back for large portions. The visitors defended doggedly though and, despite keeping the ball and keeping up the pressure, Foulds couldn't find the breakthrough and had to settle for a point as it ended goalless.

All 29 children tried their best but unfortunately we didn't finish amongst the medals this time. However the large Y5 contingent were keen to try again next year. In the meantime, we have the Cross Country Borough title to win, Quad Kids and Copthall. So plenty more athletics to come!
