Well done to Elm Class, who delivered a slick and amusing assembly on sports this week. It was fantastic to watch and very entertaining.

This week I am delighted to announce that we have won some funding through a grant. First of all I would like to say a huge thank you to the parents who were involved wit applying for the grant - they put a lot of time into the proposal and it was really appreciated. The grant will allow us to start on our work to convert the unused grey concrete space behind the canteen (the old car park) into a beautiful ECO ZONE and outdoor classroom (for KS1). The space will give Birch and Maple Classes extra space for their learning in the future and will increase biodiversity, allowing more butterflies, bees, insects and birds to thrive.

Our very active Eco Warriors, created originally last year by children in Upper Key Stage 2 has now become a whole school committee. These children, led by Mrs Ingall, have already established themselves as pioneers in ensuring we are trying to do everything we can at school to protect the environment. Gardening Club, run so brilliantly by Mrs Shepherd and Mrs Turner, has won many awards over the years for their good work. We will now all work together to create the ECO ZONE and a whole programme of community learning, linking up with older people's organisations, the food bank and other local schools to really promote biodiversity. The PTA have also agreed to help by match funding some of the building work, which we are again really grateful for as we know what a huge positive impact this project will have on the whole school.

We are seeking a number of parent volunteers to work with the school to help pave the way on the environmental side of this project. Are you passionate about the environment, climate change, ecological learning, biodiversity? Could you be available to meet quarterly to feed into this exciting programme?
