#### Orion Y5 vs Foulds Y5

Last week, Foulds' Y5 team traveled to Orion to play a pre-powerleague match. Mr Morley (the gaffa) explained the formation of 2-2-1. With No.25 up front, No.17 on the right side, No.24 on the left side with No.30 as sweeper and No.5 as the last man.

Orion kicked off with their magical No.10. They passed it around but Foulds quickly regained possession and started a counter attack. No.30 smashed it upfield and it was touched down by No.25 who took it onto his right and with power placed it in the bottom right hand corner to put Foulds 1-0 up!
