It has been a while since I mentioned growth mindset in my section of the newsletter. The children may mention that they were in the learning pit at school. This is the metaphorical pit we want them to jump into in their learning, where they are grappling to find an answer and where they understand that the mistakes that they are making are part of the learning journey. We want the children to enjoy the challenge of being in the pit in their learning, to feel safe in making mistakes, to get to an end point and in knowing that learning is hard work, but if you persevere that you will come out the other side feeling great! And of course, in climbing out of the pit, all of our school values are used: resilience and self belief (that we CAN and WILL make it out of the pit), respect, kindness and team work (working together and listening to each other when working on our learning) and responsibility (for our learning).

Next week in Key Stage Two, we are going to have the first of our house lunches of the year. This is where the children sit cross phase in their houses and is a chance to build relationships with other children in the school. We are planning a few house challenges over the coming year. One plan is to have a house cake sale competition, with the houses choosing where the money raised goes to - is there something they would like in the school that they want us to buy or do they want to donate the money to one of our school charities (e.g. Noah's Ark)? Watch this space for more on this!

We are going through a change in our uniform provider. More details will follow. There will be more choices available as well as a tightening up of our Foulds' uniform expectations but this will be phased in over time. More information to follow in the coming weeks.

FOULDS SPORTS NEWS Football vs St Andrews

St Andrews brought an A+B team down to the Byng Road playing fields to take on Y4,Y5 and Y6 Foulds teams.

In the opening games, Y6 drew 0-0 against St Andrews A but Y5 were able to find the net twice to win against St Andrews B. In the next pair of games, Y5 withstood early pressure and fought back to beat St Andrews A whilst Foulds Y4 defeated St Andrews B 4-0 in an impressive 12 minute display. In the final pair of games, Foulds Y6 edged to victory over St Andrews B whilst Foulds Y4 fought from 1-0 to draw 1-1 against St Andrews A.

Overall some promising displays with 4 wins and 2 draws from the 6 games. More importantly, the teams defended well, conceding just 1 goal over the 72 minutes of football and the teams showed resilience throughout.

Next up - friendlies against Christ Church, Alma and Dwight. League and Cup games will then commence after half-term.



Pre-season friendly vs Christ Church



Foulds took on Christ Church in a pre-season friendly at the Byng Road playing fields. Like all the games so far this season, a downpour welcomed kick-off and the game began in driving rain. Christ Church closed the ball down well and showed incisive passing to create chances and test the Foulds' goalkeeper early. The Foulds team - comprising of Y6, Y5 and Y4 Foulds players - didn't show any of the cohesiveness of playing in their year group teams the previous Friday. The team struggled to pass the ball and resorted to

clearances under pressure which went straight back to Christ Church. Despite the sterling efforts of the Foulds defence and keeper, the team conceded 3 goals by half time.

In the second half there was better link-up as Foulds started to pass and create more attacking threat. However, Christ Church remained the better team and ran out comfortable winners.

Foulds will now take on Alma on Thursday at OECC and then Dwight School next Wednesday in the final two pre-season friendlies. The team will therefore have opportunities to gel ahead of the League opener against St Andrews on Halloween.
