



Two weeks ago I talked in my newsletter about our work during the induction period on 'Maybe' by Kobi Yamada. Here is the artwork the children have created around different parts of the story. We hope you enjoy looking at it, as much as we did creating it.









Maybe you have no idea how good you really can be? And maybe you don't know how much you matter? But maybe, just maybe, the world has been waiting centuries for someone exactly like you. One thing is for sure, you are here. And because you are here... ...anything is possible.



The children have settled back into day to day life in school and are now in the full swing of their learning.

As I talked about in my last newsletter, we have created characteristics of learning across the school. Last year we worked on the starting points of metacognition (thinking about thinking), with children being able to explain their reasoning behind answers, linking to their past learning. This year, each child has chosen a 'branch' - characteristic - to work on. These characteristics support the children in their learning, but also help them to think about, and identify, what they need to do to help them; in effect making their learning visible.

This week we are revamping the Star Pupil Awards. From now on each class will award two Star Pupil certificates in the weekly assembly. The certificates are going to be based around our six values: resilience, responsibility, respect, teamwork, self belief and kindness as well as metacognition and growth mindset. Each week one of these eight themes will be chosen and the children who are embodying that value will be chosen by their teacher to receive the award. We are really looking forward to seeing who will receive the certificate each week.

Thank you all for adhering to the current bubble system. We plan to revert back to normal from Monday, with all children starting and leaving at their normal times.

Please be aware, Barnet online safety experts have been alerted to an extremely dangerous website and app called 'Monkey', which allows users to have video calls with strangers. The platform markets itself as 'an alternative to *Omegle*, with a *TikTok vibé*'. Barnet online safety experts reviewed and tested this platform and have found that it contains large amounts of inappropriate, disturbing, and harmful content transmitted via web cameras.

What is Monkey?

- Monkey is an online video chat service that is similar to Omegle or Chat Roulette, with a TikTok style interface.
- Users can talk to strangers from all over the world via webcam.
- Once a conversation is finished, or one user wishes to leave the conversation or talk to someone else, they click 'next' and are presented with a new user who could be from anywhere in the world.
- Users are asked to select their gender before meeting people.

Age Rating?

- The **website** states that all users must be over 18, but there is zero age verification. Users only have to tick a box to confirm that they are over 18. **Google Play Age Rating**: Parental Guidance.
- The app is currently **only available** on Android devices.




