What to do if....	Action needed	Return to school when...
...my child has coronavirus symptoms (persistent cough, high temperature, loss or change in taste or smell)	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> • <b>Contact school daily</b> •Self-isolate •Get a test • Inform school immediately about test result	...the test comes back negative
...my child tests positive for coronavirus	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> • <b>Contact school daily</b> •Self-isolate for at least 10 days • Inform school immediately about test result	...they feel better. They can return to school after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of smell/taste. <b>These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone.</b>
...somebody in my household has coronavirus symptoms	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> • <b>Contact school daily</b> •Self-isolate •Household member to get a test • Inform school immediately about test result	...the household member test is negative.
...somebody in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> • <b>Contact school daily</b> •Self-isolate for 14 days	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
... NHS test and trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> • <b>Contact school daily</b> •Self-isolate for 14 days	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
...we/my child travelled and has to self-isolate a part of a period of quarantine	•Do not take unauthorised leave in term time •Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel •Provide information to school as per attendance policy Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: <b>Do NOT come to school</b> •Contact school daily •Self-isolate for 14 days	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed

...we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding.	<b>Do NOT come to school</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Contact school</li> <li>•Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again</li> </ul>	...school inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again.
...my child has a cold (runny/blocked nose/sore throat) but NO coronavirus symptoms	<b>COME to school</b>	straight away!
